St. Stanislaus College was founded as an all-boy Catholic high school that was operated by the Jesuits. The college became co-educational in 1975 and became a government school in 1976, after being a Catholic institution for 110 years.

Student Body: Students come from all over Guyana.

St. Stanislaus College enrolls students in Forms 1 through Form 6. 5th Form students sit the Caribbean School Examination Committee (CSEC) examinations - the equivalent of GCE O-Levels. Those students who continue on to 6th Form sit the Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Certificate (A-Level) also set by the Caribbean Examinations Council (CXC).

Enrollment: Enrollment for the 2008-2009 school year is approximately 555 students. (Student ratio 13:1). In 2005 and 2008, St. Stanislaus College received awards for being the most improved Secondary school based on the CSEC results.

The St Stanislaus College Farm Complex is located at 69 North Sophia, Greater Georgetown, Guyana. The Complex comprises the St. Stanislaus College Farm (SSCF), the St. Stanislaus Training Centre (SSTC), the Dairy Products Unit (DPU) and the Greenhouse Vegetable Production Unit. The 13 acre Complex is owned by the St. Stanislaus College Association (SSCA) formerly the St. Stanislaus Old Boys Association.

The SSCA upholds the St Stanislaus College Farm, sometimes referred to as ‘Saints Farm’ or the ‘Dairy Farm’ as a premiere training institution for agriculture students, technicians and farmers in Guyana. Farming operations are implemented using sound scientific techniques with optimum use of resources and improved technology to ensure::

- Adding value to products thereby increasing financial returns;
- Use of renewable and recyclable resources (solar energy, manure, etc.);
- Use of environmentally-friendly material;
- Strict adherence to safety and health regulations; and
- Overall implementation of best practices.

It is a demonstration farm to promote new dairy technologies in order to serve as a catalyst to produce the required improvements in the dairy industry; a farm where farmers could be shown that the use of improved technology increases profit; and a commercial farm to use as a tool to train, farmers, farm staff, students and technicians in the use of the improved technologies.

Today the SSCF offers not only raw milk and poultry as it did in the 1970’s and 1980’s but the farm also produces humus, compost and bio-gas; produces greenhouse vegetables; produces dairy products; has an Integrated Fish and Duck Enterprise; and has a small sheep unit.

The achievements of St. Stanislaus College Farm are unrivalled in the annals of Guyana’s agricultural history.
